In April 2019 Dr. Mark Jobe was inaugurated as Moody Bible Institute’s tenth president. More than 1,800 people attended, with 6,000 viewers from 30 countries joining by livestream.

“Our history tells us what our roots are; our present tells us what our challenges are; our future tells us what opportunities we can grasp,” said Dr. Jobe.

“I believe Moody’s most compelling years are ahead of us, not behind us. I said yes to becoming the tenth president of Moody because I believe we are uniquely positioned to make a difference in Chicago, our nation, and this world, like few places before us.”

Since D. L. Moody founded the ministry in 1886, Dr. Jobe ’84, MA ’98, is the second Moody alumnus to hold the office of president. Dr. George Sweeting, who served as president from 1971 to 1987, was the first.

Improving Flight Training with New State-of-the-Art Simulators

Three Frasca Advanced Aviation Training Devices, provided by generous donors, give our students next-generation technology. Each of the three simulators incorporates a 210-degree visual projection display, which can be used to train students in both visual and instrument flight conditions.

The simulators have been incorporated into both pilot and mechanic training and are providing the option to introduce maneuvers, practice and hone skills, and review normal and emergency procedures at a significantly reduced cost to students!

Streetlights

How can God’s Word reach urban teens? Meet Esteban Shedd ’05, Aaron Lopez ’05, and Loren La Luz ’06, who created an audio Bible ministry that is intentionally engaging the global urban culture (primarily youth and young adults) with the truth of God’s Word through creative multimedia. The *Streetlights Bible* in audio, video, and print format, along with creative teaching materials, engages a generation that is primarily influenced by digital learning, which crosses cultural and learning barriers. After 10 years of ministry, Streetlights is entering a new season

of growth and development that will impact the body of Christ worldwide by expanding to new languages, smart device video teaching, and proclaiming the gospel to the next generation.

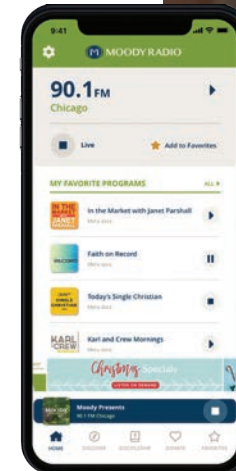

STANDING FIRM ON THE WORD: MOODY'S COMMITMENT TO SOLID DOCTRINE

Standing Firm, edited by Dr. Bryan O'Neal and Dr. John Jelinek, was written to give a fresh look at Moody Bible Institute's doctrinal statement. The book includes a chapter on Moody's history by theology professor Gregg Quiggle and expositions of core doctrines written by more than a dozen members of Moody's faculty.

Dr. O'Neal, associate provost of Moody Bible Institute, said, "Last year when Moody was going through a lot of change, some were asking questions about who we are. This was a great opportunity to affirm where we stand."

Has Moody changed any of its doctrinal positions over the years?

"We've never moved away from a position, but there have been a number of times when we've clarified or added to our affirmations. Moody's original doctrinal statement was written in 1928, and later, footnotes were added. Starting in 1983, we added statements on sign gifts, human sexuality, and gender roles in ministry. Recently Moody rewrote the first article of our doctrinal statement that deals with the deity of God. The original statement, while clear in what it intended,

wasn't worded very well. Moody's trustees invited some of the faculty to work through it and recommend a better way to formulate that first article. The new wording is better and also makes a number of robust moral claims about God's nature."

Has Moody remained committed to the essentials of orthodox Christianity?

"Our doctrine hasn't changed except where we've gotten more specific or added to our claims. One of the things about theology—and this is technically a book on theology—is that the Bible never changes. But theology is the task of speaking biblical truth to a certain culture in a certain time. So this was a chance to express those beliefs in our present cultural context. This new book is framed in the vocabulary, issues, and dialogues that are going on in the church right now."

"We've always felt the Spirit of God at Founder's Week without a question, but it was so unusual on Friday. When you can't explain something, you can only attribute that to the Spirit of God."

Called Conference

The Called Conference drew 1,000 women to Moody Bible Institute from

as far away as Florida and Oregon, gleaned ministry and leadership insights.

Dr. Pamela MacRae, program head for Ministry to Women, organized the third annual conference, which doubled in attendance from the previous year. 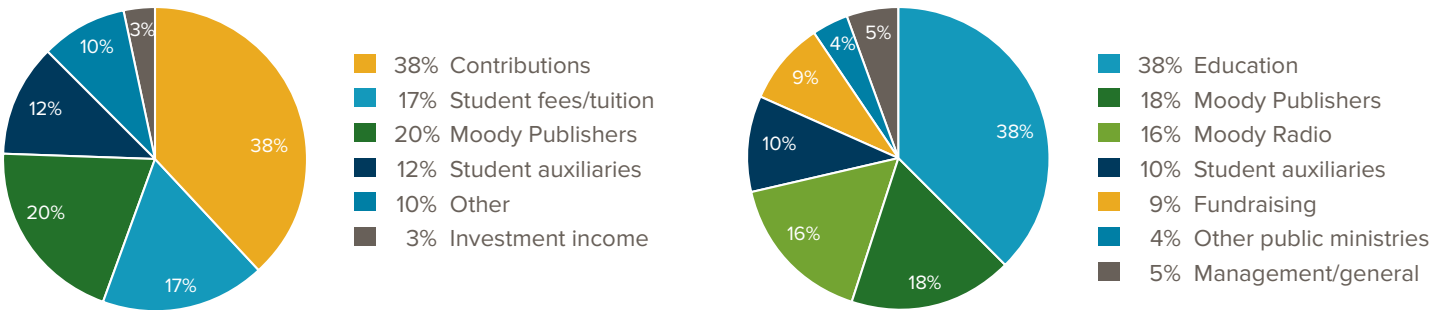
